MODERN ROADS AND HIGHWAYS In an age of automotive transportation, the Town of Burlington

has reason to be grateful for her position as "Hub of the Highways."

The Queen Elizabeth Way, Canada's most modern four-lane superhighway, the Ontario Lakeshore Highway and a vast network of traffic arteries branching north, south, east and west, provide Burlington with direct highway connections to every part of Canada and the United States.

A complete, well-organized and efficient system of motor transport, comprising over twenty individual transport companies, serves this community and permits prompt, direct motor shipment to any destination.

In addition to these complete facilities for the transport of goods, Burlington is also directly served by two excellent inter-city motor-coach systems, Canada Coach Lines and Gray Coach Lines, which supply passenger transportation and connections to all parts of the continent.
