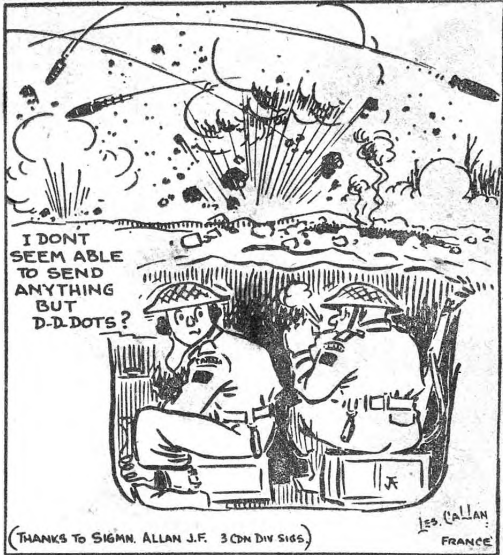


NADIANS TO HOLD FIRST
