# Hears Soldier Husband Wounded By Shrapnel

that her husband, Technical Sergeant Vernon A. Read, was wounded in action. His wound was described as a hip injury and it was stated he had been struck by shrapnel. He had been serving in England for three years and is with the Third Division. The

date of his wounding was not stated. The 37 year-old soldier enlisted in Peterboro in 1940. While overseas he was engaged in work in connection with maintenance of technical transport.
