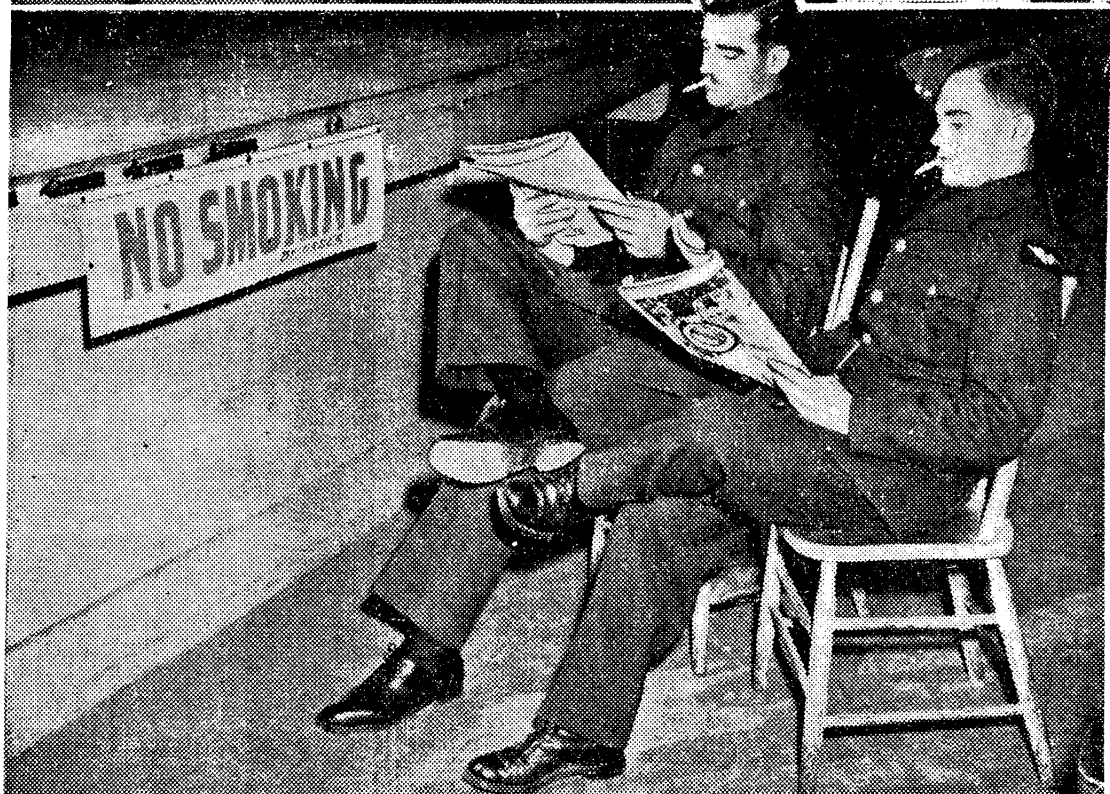


# "Defense de fumer" — "No Smoking"
