

FO. Sergeant Presumed Dead

Missing since April 5, 1945. Flying Officer Matthew Frederick Easton Sergeant, son of Mr. and Mrs. M. H. Sergeant, 547b George street, is presumed dead by the R.C.A.F. according to information received by his parents.

Born in Campbellford in June, 1922, he came to Peterborough 10 years ago. FO. Sergeant was employed as night manager at Brooks' Grill for two years and later at the Peterborough Lock Company for five years.

He enlisted August, 1942, and went overseas in August, 1944, where he served as a gunner in the crew of a Lancaster.

While in Peterborough he was a member of St. John's church and a Sunday School teacher. In March, 1943, he married Helen Henderson. Surviving are his wife and year-old baby, his parents, one sister, Mrs. R. E. Davis of Peterborough, and one brother, Carroll, at home.
