Walter's mother Mary Jane was a widow b June 15 1847, in the 1901 Bexley Census B1 P7, with children: Wm Nov 2 1873 Walter Oct 15 1879 Edgerton Sept 21 1881 Fredrick June 9 1883 The family are next door to Nicholas Breaw a widower bn Feb 3 1818 likely her father. Also Allan Breaw b July 3 1845 (wf Sarah bn May 10 1853) and further on the page is Frank Mar 11 1851 (wf Mary bn May 11 1863), probably brothers of Walter's father.

Not able to locate Walter in the 1911 census, but he listed Coboconk as his address on his 1916 attestation paper.

In 1911 Bexley Coboconk village census p2, Edgerton has married Ella, has a child John age 1 and they are all living with Mary Jane

Walter was the informant July 15 1924 on his mother's death record and was living in Coboconk. Her birthplace was given as Coboconk, but on her marriage registration, birthplace listed as Camden
