Served WW2.

Captain

Infantry, 109th Overseas Bttn., as a company commander, stationed Bramshott, Surrey. Had 15 yrs prior service in 45th Militia Reg't Victoria. 20 April 1904, became a Lieut. #6 Coy at Woodville.

Promoted to Captain 26 May 1906 #5 Coy Fenelon Falls (Vernon LeCraw: The Land Between, pp. 201-3).

Enlisted Lindsay 18 February 1916

Married Maime (Mary)
