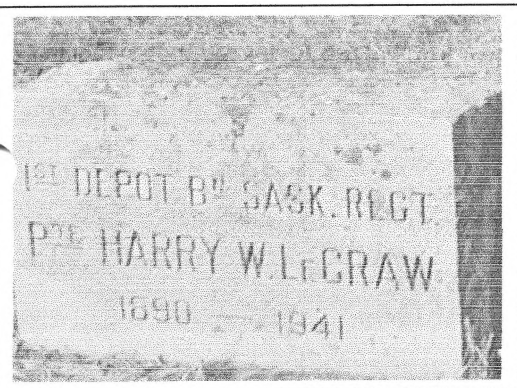
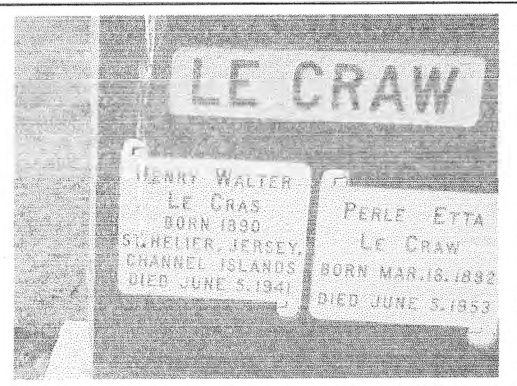


# LeCRAW, Harry (Henry Walter LeCras)
