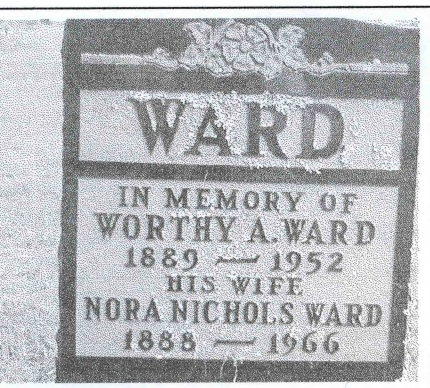


WARD, Worthy Alexander
