The funeral of the late Pte. A. M. Olesen took place at the cemetery in Coboconk and was held under military auspices. The service was conducted by the Rector of the Anglican Church, in the presence of a large concourse of friends, including a military escort and members of D Company Midland Regi-

It is stated that Pte. Olesen, who was a member of the Midland Regiment stationed at Prince Rupert, B.C., was engaged in night manoeuvres when a Bren gun carrier slipped over an embankment and fell into a few feet of water. The young soldier was pinned beneath the carrier.

Pte. Olesen was a son of Mr. and Mrs. Albert N. Olesen, of Coboconk.
