## SEEKS INFORMATION RE GRANDPARENTS

Dear Mr. Editor,

As a small boy I remember reading the "Watchman-Warder", to which my father, the late Richard Swain Smith subscribed for many years, both in Oak Park, Ill. and Omaha, Nebr.

My reason for writing is to obtain information on my grandparents, Thomas Fee and Ann Kingsbury Fee, as well as my great grandmother, Eliza Kingsbury, all of whom are buried in the Riverview Cemetery, at Lindsay.

Mr. Blackburn, the Superintendent, has already given me the dates of death and ages at death which are as follows:

Thomas Fee, Died March 20,1908, aged 78

Ann K. Fee, died Jan. 31, 1921, age 86

Eliza Kingsbury, died Jan. 20, 1875, aged 74

Thomas Fee was a mill owner and farmer. His town house (still standing in 1960) was located next to the mill, and adjacent to one of the river bridges. His farm, I believe, was about a mile west of town, on what may have been the extension of Kent St.

I would like to find out the place of birth of each of the above, particularly Thomas and Ann Fee. The cemetery does not have this data in their records, but I thought perhaps your obituary files might contain it, at least concerning Thomas Fee, who, I am told, was well known in the business circles of the town.

Any information you can give me will be gratefully received.
