This is because the natural home of wheat on the continent, where it grows to greatest per fection, is between latitudes 42 and 55. But the American territories laying in these lattindes are affected by the hot winds of the great American desert, and produce grain of interior quality, while the whest of the south is all soft. If the wheat of America, north and south, soft and hard, all soft, was allowed to be mixed with our Canadian product, we would be immense losers in our flour trade, We must remain separate if we maintai our high price for our flour. The same might be said of our apple product. They command a much higher price than the soft, tasteless American product.
