Legal Weights in Canada. The following is the Dominion Weight and Measures Act, Sect. 16, which was assented to June 18, 1898: In contracts for the sale and delivery of any of the under-mentioned articles, the bushel shall be determined by weighing, unless a bushel by measure is specially agreed upon—the weight equivalent to a bushel being as follows: Wheat, peas, beans, clover seed, potatoes, turnips, carrots, parsnips and beets 60 pounds, Hme 80 pounds, Indian corn 56 pounds, ry 56 pounds, barley 48 pounds, timothy seed 48 pounds, buckwheat 48 pounds, flax seed 56 pounds, hemp seed 44 pounds, blue grass seed 14 pounds, castor beans 40 pounds, onions 50 pounds, bluish onion 70 pounds. (2) In the Province of Quebec when potatoes are sold or offered for sale by the bag, the bag shall contain at least 30 pounds. (3) Every person who violates any provision of this section shall be liable, for a first offence, to a penalty not exceeding \$25, and for each subsequent offence, to a penalty not exceeding \$50.
