

"Rusty" Adams D.F.C. Completes Enemy Flights

Omeme, May 23 (Staff)—Flight Lieutenant Ernest Allen (Rusty) Adams, DFC son of Mrs. R J Adams and the late Mr. Adams of Omeme completed two continuous operational tours over enemy territory in Lancaster Bombers, in February 1944, and is now serving as Postings Officer in Southern England. Fl. Lt. Adams was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross in November 1943 and also has earned the Permanent Pathfinders Badge.

He enlisted in the Royal Canadian Air Force in January 1941 and trained in Toronto, Montreal and Mountain View. In December 1941 he graduated at Mountain View as a Wireless Air Gunner and being one of the "top four" in his class he received his Commission of Pilot Officer. Further promotions to Flying Officer and then to Flight Lieutenant were given to him over seas.

On April 15, 1944 Fl. Lt. Adams was married to Daphne Irene Taylor of Cambridge, England. The ceremony was performed in one of the Anglican churches in Cambridge.

Another son of Mrs. Adams, Sgt. Lewis Adams is serving in the Provost Corps of the RCAF and is stationed in Toronto. Two sons-in-law are serving with the Canadian Army, Sgt. Lewin Brown RCASC who is Pay Sergeant at Artillery Park Kingston and Sgt. William Wedlock who is serving with the RCOC in Italy. *November 23 1944*
