## Centennial medal for Ford Moynes



Ford Moynes, reporter, editor and newspaper columnist for nearly fifty years is a recipient of the Centennial medal, given for service to the nation.

Ford Moynes who writes the popular "On the Main Street" column for "The Post", is the oldest living Past Master of Faithful Brethren Lodge, No. 77, A.F. and A.M. He is a past-president and past lieutenant-governor of Kiwanis International. Ford has nearly 40 years of perfect Kiwanis attendance.

Other recipients of the Centennial medal in Lindsay include former Ontario premier Leslie Frost, Judge H. E. Richardson, former Legion zone commander Ian Scott, Rev. O. G. Locke and militia member S/Sgt. H. G. Green, Bdr. W.A. Sissons and W.O. 2 J. F. K. Green.
