Tragedy Strikes Yelverton When Fire at McCabe Barn Destroys Many Years Work

Yelverton: Tragedy struck in Yelverton community at our closest neighbour, the Wm. McCabes, on Wednesday, Aug. 21 when fire swept through their 40 x 100 hip-roofed bank barn and wiped out produce, hay, straw and grain from cellar to peak as well as certain livestock.

Cabes' good Shorthorn sire—that was offered an escape refused to face the heat and thus declined his own salvation. The 32 hogs likewise refused to budge, (11 ready for market); the fire also claimed 10 calves and a number of hens.

It was providential that the wind blew from a northeast direction (the first time for weeks) thus saving house and driving shed. As it was, the heat was so intense that the metal on the shed would burn your hand.
