Consider late french immersion program

The Education committee of the Board of Education has supported a report recommending late french immersion programs which would begin at the grade 6 level.

It has been suggested that such a program be instituted in three locations, Port Hope, Brighton and the M.J. Hobbs school in Hampton.

Up to this point children had to enrol in french immersion at kindergarten level. The late immersion program would present other options to students and parents that have not been available up to this time. The board last year turned down the late immersion program but the committee has revived the proposal.

The committee suggests a survey of parents of Grade 5 students be conducted to determine interest for such a program.

gram would be a partial program with students receiving 50 percent French instruction and fifty percent in English instruction.
