Saturday October 25th took us to Newcastle. With no scoring in the first, we knew it was going to be a good game. In the second, Newcastle tucked one in past the Leaf's goaltender, Kevin Marin. Shortly after this, Newcastle struck again taking a 2-0 lead.

On a bad bounce off the boards, Newcastle slipped another shot home to make it a 3-0 lead. Determined to battle back, #93 Brain Pisani made a great play up the wing that ended with some excellent stick handling by #2 Doug Garlick and a short-handed goal. Only two minutes were left when Orono cut the lead with a goal from #33 Evan Moore and assist to #4 Devon Sutton. Orono was desperately generating offense and they got caught deep in Newcastle's end. Newcastle

scored another goal to make it 4-2. Another tough loss for the Midgets.

On October 26th, the Leafs hosted Manver's Mustangs. The first period was a familiar dead even finish. Orono picked up the pace in the second with #4 Devon Sutton walking out front from the corner to put one home. This gave Orono a 1-0 lead with the assist to #10 Greg Howe. It deflected again to the left side, almost parallel with the goal line. Chad Moore was waiting for it and shot it, amazingly, into the top right hand corner of the net! The tie didn't hold for long before Bowmanville took the lead again. Fabricus performed his magic once again deking out everyone and shot at the net. The puck hit the goalie and ricocheted in. It was 4-4 with four minutes left. The action was back and forth, the crowd hooted and clapped, but no more scores were to be had, the game ended in a tie.


