In 1964 an electric heating system was installed in the church by Gordon Harris, to replace the insufficient oil heater and faithful old box stove that had been there for many years. It has proven satisfactory and all the men turned out to help. There was a canvass for funds and manual labor was given freely.

Some of those helping who have not been previously mentioned in connection with the church were Jack Lancaster, Irvine Goheen, Elmer Lightle, Victor Lightle, Irwin Moore and perhaps others whose names may have been overleoked.

In the years 1964 and 1965, the roof and outside trim on the church as well as the interior, seats and floor, have all received a coat of paint. The vestibule at the rear entrance or the church was completely renovated with new ceiling, wall panelling, tile floor, curtains, a bit of paint and coat rack were purchased.

Women's Organization

The expense of the work

was partly covered by bequests left by Miss Jessie Lightle, the rest shared between church board and U.C.W. and a donation from Edgar Moore.

The women's organization depends on a Spring supper in May and a turkey dinner in the Autumn. Some of the former members join in these undertakings and their help is greatly appreciated.

Some mention might be made here of Mrs. Stanley Etcher, deceased, who gave so freely of time and energy whenever she was asked to take part. She served as president for many years, and was treasurer of the Women's Group for 14 years. Mrs. Edgar Moore was a staunch supporter of Bethel Grove church, and others were yery faithful and deserve credit for their work also.
