## INAUGURAL ADDRESS - DECEMBER 9, 1985

- THE COUNCIL YOU HAVE ELECTED TO SERVE COBOURG DURING THE NEXT THREE YEARS HAS BEEN ELECTED ON THE NEED FOR A CHANGE AND POSITIVE ACTION. THERE IS A NEED TO ENCOURAGE GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT IN THE INDUSTRIAL, THE COMMERCIAL, THE RETAIL, AND THE TOURIST INDUSTRIES. THIS COUNCIL, WITH THE CO-OPERATION OF OUR CITIZENS, WILL WORK TOWARD THESE GOALS.
- 2. IT IS ESSENTIAL IF WE ARE TO PROVIDE THE NECESSARY SERVICES
  AND MEET THE NEEDS OF THE PEOPLE OF COBOURG THAT OUR GOALS
  FOR GROWTH MUST BE TO CREATE MORE JOBS THUS GIVING A BROADER
  TAX BASE TO FINANCE OUR PROGRAMS.
- 3. IT WILL BE NECESSARY FOR THIS COUNCIL TO BRING INTO BEING SOME SOUND PLANNING AND PRIORITIES SO THAT DIRECTION CAN BE GIVEN TO OUR TOWN ADMINISTRATION TO FULFILL THEIR RESPONSIBILITIES.
- 4. IT MUST BE RECOGNIZED THAT WITHOUT SOME SOUND PLANNING AND DIRECTION, PROGRESS WILL BECOME DIFFICULT TO ACHIEVE. SOME OF THE PROJECTS THAT MUST BE GIVEN PRIORITY IN PREPARING A PLAN ARE:
- 5. THE DEVELOPMENT OF LUCAS POINT INDUSTRIAL PARK. A DETAILED PLAN OF HOW SERVICES, ROADS AND OTHER SUPPORT REQUIREMENTS ARE GOING TO BE PROVIDED. THIS TYPE OF PLANNING IS ESSENTIAL IF WE ARE TO CARRY OUT ANY FORM OF PROMOTION FOR THIS PARK. A PLANNED AND PROPERLY DEVELOPED PARK WILL BE THE KEY TO MORE JOBS IN THE INDUSTRIAL SECTOR.
- 6. A HARBOUR DEVELOPMENT PLAN. TO DEVELOP A DETAILED PLAN FOR
  THE HARBOUR WE WILL NEED INPUT FROM OUR COMMERCIAL AND RETAIL
  COMMUNITY AS WELL AS CITIZENS AT LARGE. THE HARBOUR DEVELOPMENT
  REMAINS A KEY TO TOURIST GROWTH. WE MUST REMEMBER TO KEEP IT
  A PEOPLE PLACE FOR ALL OUR CITIZENS TO ENJOY.

- 7. A PLAN MUST BE PREPARED FOR THE EXPANSION OF SEWER SERVICES,

  'AND IMPROVED ROADS, TO THOSE AREAS NOT PRESENTLY SERVED. IN

  SETTING PRIORITIES FOR PROVIDING THESE SERVICES WE MUST

  RECOGNIZE THE URGENCY AND THE NEED TO PROTECT THE HEALTH OF OUR

  CITIZENS, THE ENVIRONMENT AND OUR ECOLOGY. CONTINUAL DELAYS

  IN DOING THIS WORK CAN ONLY LEAD TO PROBLEMS FOR THE NEXT

  GENERATION.
- 8. THE DEVELOPMENT, IN CO-OPERATION WITH THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNTY, OF FUTURE WASTE DISPOSAL SITES MUST BE RESOLVED. FURTHER DELAYS WILL ONLY CONTRIBUTE TO OUR EXISTING PROBLEMS.
- 9. THE MUNICIPAL HOUSING AUTHORITY HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED AND WILL WORK WITH PROVINCIAL AND FEDERAL HOUSING AGENCIES TO DEVELOP AND PROVIDE MORE AFFORDABLE LEVELS OF HOUSING FOR COBOURG.
- 10. TOURISM IS PRESENTLY ONTARIO'S SECOND LARGEST INDUSTRY AND IS EXPECTED TO BE NUMBER ONE BY 1990. WE MUST WORK TO EXPAND OUR POTENTIAL AND OBTAIN A GREATER SHARE OF THIS MARKET. OUR RETAIL AND COMMERCIAL BUSINESS MUST PLAY A CONTINUING ROLE IN ACHIEVING THIS GOAL.
- OUR YOUNG PEOPLE. THESE JOBS MUST BE CHALLENGING JOBS. (IF THE YOUNG PEOPLE ARE EXPECTED TO REMAIN IN CORRUSCIETY IS FACED WITH THE REALITY THAT MANY JOBS EXISTING TODAY WILL NOT BE HERE IN TEN YEARS. NEW JOBS ARE COMING INTO BEING AND WE MUST ENSURE THAT OUR YOUNG PEOPLE ENTERING THE WORK FORCE HAVE TRAINING OR ARE RETRAINED TO MEET THE NEW JOB MARKET AS IT DEVELOPS. WE MUST ACCEPT THAT EDUCATION AND TRAINING WILL BE A CONTINUING WAY OF LIFE FOR FUTURE GENERATIONS IT WILL NOT END WITH A DIPLOMA OR DEGREE.

- OUR SENIOR CITIZENS CONTINUE TO BE A GROWING FORCE IN OUR COMMUNITY. WE MUST EXTEND TO THEM THE OPPORTUNITIES TO PARTICIPATE AND GIVE US THE BENEFIT OF THEIR EXPERIENCE. THEY CAN PROVIDE A WEALTH OF EXPERIENCE TO MANY OF OUR COMMITTEES. THEY WILL CONTINUE TO HAVE A VERY INFLUENTIAL EFFECT ON OUR ECONOMY AND ITS GROWTH.
- 13. IN WHATEVER PLANS AND PROGRAMS WE DEVELOP IN THE FUTURE WE MUST ACKNOWLEDGE THAT OUR BOUNDARIES WITH SURROUNDING MUNICIPALITIES ARE SHRINKING. WE MUST BE PREPARED TO CO-OPERATE WITH OUR NEIGHBOURS IN THE COUNTY OF NORTHUMBERLAND AND DEVELOP A STRATEGY OF GROWTH WHICH WILL BENEFIT ALL OF US. THE DIAMOND TRIANGLE IS A BEGINNING FOR PROMOTING, BUT IT WILL REQUIRE REFINEMENT TO MEET ALL OUR NEEDS. WE MUST ENSURE THAT INDUSTRY, COMMERCIAL AND RETAIL BUSINESS AND THE TOURISM INDUSTRY ALL HAVE AN OPPORTUNITY TO BE REPRESENTED AND GIVE DIRECTION TO THIS AGENCY.
- 14. WHILE I HAVE TRIED TO TOUCH ON SOME OF THE ISSUES THAT ARE OF VITAL CONCERN I AM AWARE THERE ARE OTHERS AND MORE WILL BECOME EVIDENT AS WE PROGRESS IN THE NEW YEAR BUT I BELIEVE IF WE START OUT IN THIS COUNCIL IN A SPIRIT OF CO-OPERATION AND DESIRE TO SERVE THE CITIZENS OF COBOURG WE WILL BE SUCCESSFUL.
- 15. FROM OUR CITIZENS WE ASK YOUR SUPPORT AND UNDERSTANDING AND A REMINDER THAT OUR STRENGTH IS IN OUR UNANIMITY.
- 16. TO THOSE OF YOU WHO HAVE TAKEN THE TIME TO ATTEND COUNCIL
  THIS EVENING WE EXTEND OUR THANKS AND HOPE YOU WILL CONTINUE
