PROPOSED ACTION PLANS

**MARINE FACILITIES COMMITTEE:**

Action has already begun at the harbour with repairing the west break wall and dredging. Much progress is being made with powers that be towards proposed marina with gas and pump-out facilities, green area, and all-round beautification at the water front.

**EDUCATION COMMITTEE:**

Several meetings have been held with counsellor of both Collegiates with much exchange of ideas and future planning, which includes work experience, seminars, etc.

**PROGRAM OF WORK COMMITTEE:**

Proposal to revitalize the farmers' market. Interest has been shown to include hobby craft articles and home made products. Committee encourages Industrial displays at Home 'N Sportsman Show, and support investigation as to the feasibility of covering swimming pool. Will determine a worthwhile community project for L.I.P. grant application in September of 1977.

**SAFETY COMMITTEE:**

Plans to co-operate with various safety groups and promote safety. Arouse public awareness and participation in safety measures in industry, home, fire prevention, water and highway safety.

**MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE:**

Campaign will take place in March, also in day to day communication.

**TOURIST COMMITTEE:**

Plans to re-locate Tourist booth on Hwy. #2 with appropriate signs.

**BOARD OF DIRECTORS:**

Investigating the possibility of "A Day in the Park - Water Festival". Interested in the promotion of "Participaction". Contributed to the realization of new numbering By-Law promoted by Fire Prevention Committee.
