1927 The Commencement

The week of Friday, November the fifth might be termed Commencement week, as our Commencement Exercises were then held for the first time in the history of our school.

Early on Friday afternoon the activities began. In the gymnasium, which was tastefully decorated with the school colours, the girls gave a very enjoyable afternoon tea for the mothers of the pupils. After this, the boys Rugby Team from Albert College was entertained from 6:00 to 7:30, at which time the members of the orchestra displayed their talents.

The main event, the Commencement Exercises, took place on Friday Evening at 8:00 o'clock. The gymnasium was crowded with visitors, and members of the Collegiate Board, school staff and town council occupied the platform. Mr. Davidson outlined the object of the gathering, and introduced the staff, after which came the presentation of the diplomas. First the graduation diplomas by Mr. Hewson, then the Upper School certificates by Mr. McCullagh who urged a remedy for the overcrowded condition of the school. Mr. Fullerton presented the Middle School certificates, Mr. Johns the Lower School certificates and Dr. Ferris the Commercial diplomas. Mr. McClelland gave a brief explanation as to how the athletic prizes were awarded, then Colonel Odell gave out the boys' Athletic prizes, Mrs. D. Macdonald gave an interesting talk for the girls, and distributed the girls' Field Day awards. After this His Honor Judge McGlade spoke briefly, but to the point, about ideals in athletics, and then awarded the medals won at the Provincial District Meet together with the efficiency medals. Finally, Miss Field presented some History prizes to those passing highest in that subject in the entrance exams and Mr. Davidson prizes for the oratory and elocutionary contests. A pleasant break in the program was a recitation and a reading by Edna Grasley, and a duet by Ena Austin and Edith Ellison. All were unanimous in declaring the evening a success.

On Saturday afternoon, November 6th., the senior classes entertained the graduation classes at a tea dance. Because of the splendid music provided by the school orchestra, the fine floor, delicious refreshments and large number of students, most of whom knew each other, the dance was particularly enjoyable and appreciated by the young people.

The commencement weekend was a great success, and one which we hope to repeat each year. In this way the public may get an idea of what we are doing at C. C. I.
