Tractors made in their own countries will be used by the competitors also according to the rules.

Tractor and plow equipment from overseas was shipped to Canada early in August so that the visitors will be able to comply with the rules.

It has also been disclosed that this year's championship match may be the last held in Canada for some years since it is the intention of the promotors to hold it in a different country each year and Canada's turn might be a long time coming again.

This means that a signal honor has come to Cobourg never before given to any other town in Canada.

It also means that Cobourg will have the honor of being the first site of the World's Plowing Match, something that no other town or city can claim.
