William Andrew was the eldest son of John and Euphemia Weir and was born at Mar. He enlisted in the First World War on March 3, 1917, and went overseas October 3rd, that same year. He arrived home May 19th, 1919. In 1920 he and his brother Archie bought their parents' farm, Lot 23 Con 1 EBR, when the parents relocated. In 1927, William married Violet Della of Amabel. In 1928 they bought the farm across the road, Lot 22 Con 1 EBR.

Andrew D. and Mary (Adams) Weir Jr.

Andrew was the youngest son of Andrew Sr. and Mary Weir. He was born at Mar and lived there all his life. In 1902 he married Mary Adams, daughter of Robert and Elizabeth Adams Sr. of Mar, natives of County Cavan, Ireland.

Andrew and his wife bought Lot 16 Con 2 EBR in 1904. In 1910 they purchased his parents' farm when they retired to Amabel Township. They also added Lot 16 Con 1 EBR to their holdings.

Mr. and Mrs. Weir served as Sunday School teachers at Mar Presbyterian Church for nearly half a century. Mr. Weir was also an Elder. He served on Albemarle Township Council for a few years.

Mrs. Weir was a Charter member and first President of the Mar Women's Institute and was active in this organization for many years. She served as District President and was on the Federated Board for one term. In later years she was presented with a Life Membership and Pin from the Mar W.I. Mr. and Mrs. Weir were honoured on their 50th. Wedding Anniversary with a dinner, gifts, and a social time by the congregation, community and relatives.

Mr. and Mrs. Weir had one son, William Earl, of London.
