Robert Charles Kerr and his wife Mary McGregor came to Mar from Brussels in 1898. Mr. Kerr farmed and had a smith-shop and blacksmith shop in part of the building with his brother-in-law Wm. McGregor. He moved later to a vacant building on his farm where he set up his blacksmith shop and carried on this business for years.
