

Tuffnells.

Wm. Tuffnell B 1862 - 1935. Came to Mar area as a young man from Woodstock and settled on 100 acres Lot 8 Con 1 E. B.R. what is now known as Lumberlost. As several people from the Woodstock area came about that time they named it Little Woodstock and it remained that name for several years. He married a Mar girl Elizabeth Mc Miller B. 1866 - 1925.

In 1911 they bought 100 acres Lot 14 Con 3 E. B.R. and they moved there with their family. The Tuffnells were members of Mar Baptist Church.

A clipping from Echo at Wheaton dated May 1913 reads, Mr. Tuffnell occupied the pulpit in Mar Baptist Church on Sunday, talking for his subject - the "Resurrection".
