

Albermarle Council meets 1966.

The Albermarle Council met at Colfax Bay on Feb. 4, with all members present. Mr. C. H. <sup>Call</sup> Whicker and Bert Carson interviewed the Council soliciting a grant towards the proposed new addition to the Hospital in Winton, and the Council promised a grant of \$5,000, payable over a period of five years, subject to the approval of the Board Municipal Board.

The Council also approved of the proposed addition to Winton District High School. The Township will become responsible for its share of the debentures to cover the cost of the same.

Mrs. Ronald Gatis and Mr. Hugh Thomas were appointed township representatives on the Grey-Bruce Tourist Council.

The Road Superintendent was instructed to advertise with the Northern Townships for crushing and stock-piling approximately 10,000 cubic yards of gravel for Albermarle Township.

The Reeve was instructed to sign road vouchers No 2 for \$2,274.06.

The Clerk was instructed to advertise for a Road Superintendent to commence duties on April 1st. Applications to be on Township forms.
