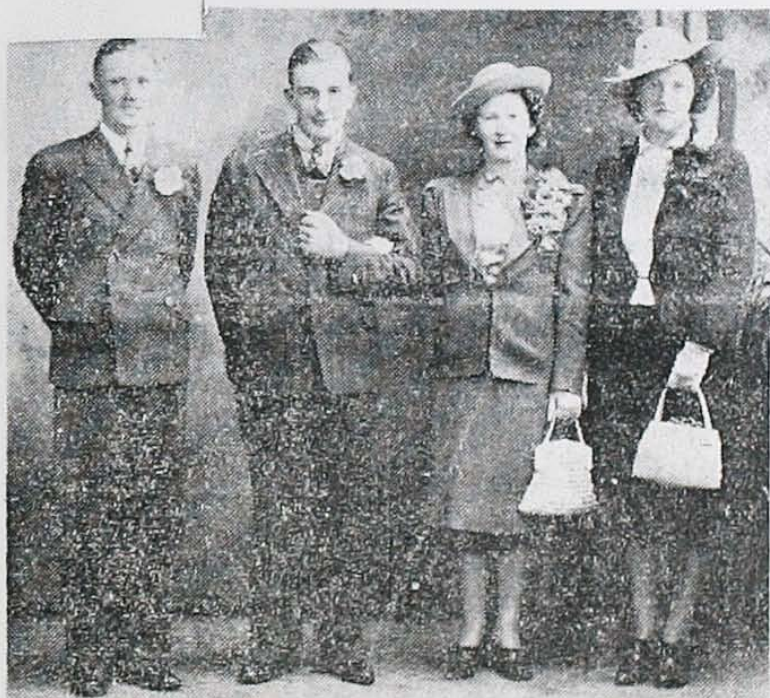
Reception and Dinner Served at the Seldon House
