Mr. and Mrs. McKenzie will reside in Keady after a wedding trip north.

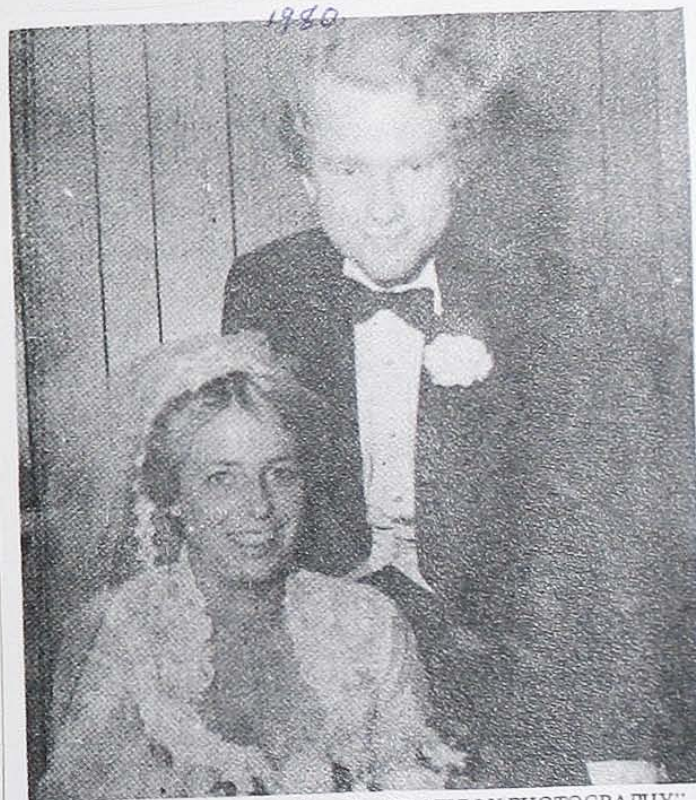
