Record to date of Lot, Township Of Horton

Lot 19, Township of Horton, 7th concession dates back to Sept. 9, 1854, when James Campbell of Lanark Co., Province of Canada sold this parcel of land for 150 £. sterling. Property consisted of 200 acres.

Oct, 1855 conveyance of property between James Campbell and George Kerr, merchant of Perth took place for the sum of 160 £. sterling.

July 28, 1857, George Kerr sold this property to John Finan, Gentleman of the city of Ottawa, for the sum of 200 £. sterling.

John Finan was born Sept. 15, 1811 at Bandon, Cork Co., Ireland and his wife Sarah Corbett was born April 9, 1811 in Westmeath Co.

Ireland. After a military career as Sergeant Major of the 69th. Regiment of the Irish Fusiliers, Mr. Finan and his family settled in Bytown as Ottawa was then known.

John Finan was paymaster of veterans pensions and on his retirement purchased the above farm, where he and his wife resided till their deaths.

Their family consisted of 7 daughters and 3 sons who were born in 5 different countries.

Oct. 2. 1853, Allison, Bytown, Ont., Canada.

Dec. 7. 1855, George, Bytown, Ont.
