

With respect to priorities, the residents of Porquis Junction have established the following order of priority if Federal or Provincial funding is not available for the entire Program:

1. Sanitary Sewage Collection and Disposal System;
2. Water Supply and Distribution System;
3. Enlarge Fire Hall;
4. Streetlighting;
5. Playground and Recreation Preparation and Equipment;
6. Official Plan Revision;
7. Upgrade Streets;
8. Storm Sewer installation;
9. Sidewalk Replacement and Addition;
10. New Culverts;
11. Street Signs;
12. Community Centre;
13. Acquisition of Derelict Buildings.

If funding for the Program is curtailed, then the residents, with the concurrence of Council, wish to see elements of the Program implemented in accordance with the above priorities. When and if other neighbourhood requirements are identified, they will be inserted in appropriate places in the priority listing. It is assumed that since RRAP and the rehabilitation of commercial buildings are funded separately, they need not be included in the list of priorities.

7. PREPARATION FOR IMPLEMENTATION

In order to ensure the appropriate implementation of the Program, the Town will ensure that there is adequate staff capability, with permanent staff or consultants to undertake the Program in accordance with the Town's requirements as well as with the guidelines of CMHC and the Province. The
