

HISTORY

- 1) When the town of Monteith was moved from one side of the river to the other side after the fire of 1916, Mr. McGee's house (2 3rd Ave Monteith) was to be the first school built in the new location.
- 2) What is now Mr. Page's, was at one time, The United Church in the town of Monteith or Driftwood City.
- 3) There were two (2) great fires in Monteith. One in 1916 but also one in 1915, and Kate Hoffman had survived both. In the 1915 fire her father had built a water hole in which they went into and poured water over themselves to prevent themselves from being, in her words, "Fried !"
- 4) Mrs. Denise Purdy's house was once John Whitton's house. (6 2nd Ave Monteith)
- 5) Mrs. Hoffman lived two (2) miles from Monteith on a farm, accross from the cemetery.

GAMES

- 1) Hide and go seek: One person would cover their eyes and count while the others went to hid.
- 2) Aunts over: Two children would be on one side of the house while two others where on the other side. One side would throw the ball over the house while screaming Auts Over, then they would run around the house to try to touch the other two who were waiting for the ball.
