

Valedictorian, winners found after slight mishap

Gremlins in the works at The Enterprise prevented Patrick Hetherington from being identified as valedictorian at graduation exercises held June 23 for the final time at Monteith-Shillington Public School.

The lines of type identifying Hetherington as spokesman for his graduating class were inadvertently omitted from the story on page B4 of the July 6 issue of the newspaper.

The paragraph should have read: "Charlie Shields announced that this year's valedictorian was Patrick Hetherington. Hetherington reminisced about his years at the school, and expressed

regret that the school is being closed. He also said this year's school production was fine."

Another mistake was made in a cutline accompanying a photograph of award winners. Melissa Gervais is named as student contributing the most to the school, while, in fact, she is holding the trophy for that distinction for Audrey Simon, who was also the best camper.
