

Death of William H. Taylor Nov 3rd/73

Monteith lost one of its pioneers when death claimed the life of William, H. Taylor, 75^{yo.} late of Iroquois Falls, Ont. Death occurred on Nov 3. in McConkey, Ont where the late Mr Taylor had gone on a hunting expedition with friends when stricken.

Surviving are his wife, the former Lillian Watts, 2 daughters, Kaye, (Mrs Lauri Koski of Monteith) Jackie (Mrs Jack Cameron of Iroquois Falls) One sister, Dorothy, (Mrs Carl Sunden of Courtney, B.C.) 2 brothers, Reg and Norman of Nanaimo, B.C. 4 grandchildren and one great grandchild.

Before moving to Iroquois Falls, the late Mr Taylor had been a resident of Monteith for many years having come here as a young man.

Funeral Services were conducted by Rev Chas Locke of Matheson and were held in St Marys Anglican Church in Monteith, Ont at 2 P.M. on Nov 7, 1973.
