

4-H AWARDS

Each 4-H girl who completes a project receives an award in the progress she makes in knowledge, skills and human relations. Since 1957 each girl receives a sterling silver 4-H Homemaking Club spoon. Before this a spoon was provided by the Conty. After six clubs or units are completed a certificate and pin are awarded. This is called County Honours. When twelve units are completed, a pin and certificate signify Provincial Honours. The ultimate award is known as Advanced Honours and is presented after eighteen units have been completed.
