

THIS INDENTURE

made the *Twenty seventh* day of *September* one thousand eight hundred and eighty *seven*

In Pursuance of the Act respecting Short Forms of Conveyances;

Between *John Johnston (the Elder) of the Village of Waldemar in the County of Dufferin and Province of Ontario (Essextonen) (widower)* and *John Johnston (the younger) James A McFadyen and Andrew Boyle all of the said Village of Waldemar*

of the Congregation of *Waldemar* TRUSTEES of the Second Part; and

Whereas, the Congregation of *Waldemar*

is a Congregation of the religious body known as the PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH IN CANADA, and whereas the said Congregation desires to take a conveyance of the lands hereinafter mentioned, under the provisions of the Act respecting the property of Religious Institutions in the Province of Ontario, and subject to the provisions of the Act passed in the thirty-eighth year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act respecting the Union of certain Presbyterian Churches therein named; and whereas the said Congregation have appointed

John Johnston (the younger) James A McFadyen and Andrew Boyle (aforesaid)

Trustees, to whom and their successors, to be appointed in the manner hereinafter specified, the said lands may be conveyed, and who may take, hold and possess the same by the said name of *the Waldemar Congregation* under the provisions of the said Act.

Now this Indenture Witnesseth that in consideration of *one dollar of lawful money of Canada*

now paid by the said parties of the Second Part to the said parties of the First Part (the receipt whereof do hereby acknowledge) he the said part of the First Part do grant unto the said parties of the Second Part, their successors and assigns forever, all and singular

that certain tract or parcel of land and premises situated lying and being in the Township of Amaranth in the County of Dufferin and Province of Ontario comprised of a portion of the East half of lot number two in the tenth concession of the said Township of Amaranth - being more particularly shown and described as follows commencing at the distance of two chains and twenty two links westerly from the westerly limit of the allowance for Road between the north and tenth concession of the said Township on a straight line drawn parallel to the boundary between lot numbers two and three in the said tenth concession from a point twenty two chains fifty links southerly from the north-easterly angle of said lot number two thence north - ninety degrees - seven minutes
