



This is a picture of our C.P.R. stock yards which we built shortly after the station and are still being used to load cattle, pigs and sheep. Part of these were torn down in 1960. This station was built in the year 1930 without living quarters. The other station was burnt on account of sickness. The agents were Joseph Lomas, Hector McDonald, Jack Roberts, Mrs. Walter Brown, Walter Brown Jr. , Charlotte Rennick. The station was bought by James Finlay and moved to his lot, the former Price residence.

The village was lit by street lights in 1961.
