



This picture is what at one time was the "Blue Stone Hotel" owned by John Brown who later sold to Mr. Hicks and then to Forgraves in August 1889 who done a thriving business.

It was later sold to William Lovell as a residence and Glendenning now to Wedrick which is a beautiful summer resort.

At one time there was a shed in connection with the hotel and there was a hall over it where the Anglican minister from Grand Valley held services every two weeks.

There was a lime kiln just south of this shed which run for years. Mrs. Ward bought this home. In 1956 was sold to Ben McCallum from Woodbridge. In 1963 (Dec.) Mr. Bevin of Rexdale bought it.



Mr. William Burke kept store in this building for a number of years later selling to Mr. Haggerty.

William Boyle later bought the house and now it is owned by Michael Rennick.



A Mr. Wilkinson started store in this building later selling to John Henry , Mrs. Albert Simpson, Joe McConachie. Then later John Groskurth kept store there for a few years. Lew Groskurth bought the house and then Jack Roberts lived there and today it is owned by Harve, Emme Forgrave and Mrs. Reid with William Millers living in the front. Mr. & Mrs. Jones of Toronto lived in this house in 1950. Then John K. Warnock until 1959. In 1964 Harold Burke purchased this house from Mrs. T. W. Reid.
