

The Arthur Graves Home

The home of Mr. and Mrs. Arthur Graves has been let 11 in the village of Waldemar since November 1950.

It is located on Station Street and is part of the west half of lot 3, in the ninth conc session of the township of Amaranth.

Mr. Lomas owned 100 acres of land which he received from the Crown and sold this lot to a Mr. Witmer for fifty dollars. In 1883 he sold to George Barnhart for \$300. Mr. Barnhart passed away and his wife remained here until her death. So late in 1950 Mr. Graves bought the property from the Barnhart estate.

Mr. and Mrs. Graves still live in their residence in Waldemar. They celebrated their Golden Wedding on July 5th, 1972.
