

The ARNOLD GAMBLE Farm (continued)

In 1944 the driving shed and pigpen collapsed due to heavy weight of the snow. Gravel was taken from a pit on this farm at intervals over a period of years for road and highway construction.

Wilfred died in 1951 and his son Arnold purchased the farm for 6000.00 dollars. Wilfred's wife Vera lived on the homestead until her death in 1963. In 1965 Arnold married Janet Murray.

The buildings were wired for hydro in 1952 and a steel roof was put on the barn in 1957. A steel driving shed was built west of the barn in 1961. A complete pressure system and furnace were installed in 1964. A second driving shed was built to the east of the barn in 1976.
