Installation of a new Watermain on Boston Church Road/Third Line from the Zone 5 Reservoir to the future James Snow Parkway (Regional Road 4) and on James Snow Parkway from Boston Church Road/Third Line to Steeles Avenue (Regional Road 8) Towns of Halton Hills (Georgetown) and Milton, PR-2349C

Halton Region is proposing to install a new watermain along the following roads:

- Boston Church Road/Third Line from Zone 5 Reservoir (end of Hume Court) to the future James Snow Parkway
- James Snow Parkway from Third Line to Steeles Avenue

A Public Information Centre will be held to provide residents with an opportunity to review the project drawings and to discuss any potential construction disruptions that may result from the proposed works.
