For those suffering from BPPV, she performs a head manoeuvre to guide the crystals of the inner ear back into place. Clients notice improvement in just one or two visits. After viral inner ear infections, she helps clients with exercises to retrain their balance and vision.

Since Jenni is one of the few Canadian physiotherapists with specialized vestibular training, she has had clients come from as far away as Thunder Bay and Alberta for treatment. For the most part, she treats her clients in the comfort of their own homes, but does treat out-of-towners at her house. A doctor's referral is not required and treatment is covered by most extended healthcare plans.

"I like how drastically I can change how somebody feels," Jenni says. "When someone is experiencing inner ear problems, it's very hard for other people to understand because it's not like a broken leg; you can't see it. I can help them feel better quickly and get back to what they enjoy doing."
