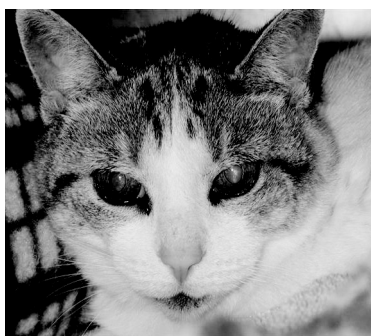
Lonely, neglected Mitsou is looking for love

Cayman is a young energetic dog but this is easily controlled when walking by using a Gentle Leader. In fact Cayman gets extra walks as even near the highway he behaves “like a gentleman”. We would suggest training would be fun and

educational for Cayman and his new family. Training would help with bonding, made easier by his love of treats and his report card from our caregivers reveal a happy and fun young man who they feel has huge potential!
