

Two candidates declared so far

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With these ballots people can vote at their local returning office for 28 days, from Sept. 8 to Oct. 5, and they have 23 days to apply for a special ballot to vote by mail, Sept. 8 to Sept. 30.

There will also for the first time be 15 days (Sept. 21-Oct. 5) to vote using assistive voting technology. It includes different pieces of assistive technology, such as a sip and puff device, paddles and also a controller similar to video game joy sticks. These kinds of devices are usually intended for people with disabilities.

The 10 days of advance polls will run from Sept. 21 to Sept. 30. The dates, times and locations of the advance polls will be provided on the Notice of Registration Card.

To date there are two confirmed candidates in the Wellington-Halton Hills riding.

Wellington-Halton Hills MPP Ted Arnott was acclaimed last November as his party's (PC) official candidate.

Arnott was first elected to the Ontario Legislature in 1990 and has had four consecutive re-elections.

Arnott is looking forward to the election saying it's an "exciting opportunity" to meet thousands of people in the riding. His campaigning will begin in September, he said.

Dale Hamilton of Eden Mills was acclaimed as the NDP candidate in the riding on June 29.

Hamilton ran against Arnott in the 1990 election in Wellington. She served as a municipal councillor in the pre-amalgamation township of Eramosa.

She has served as an education officer with Environmental Commissioner of Ontario, a tribunal member with the Farm Products Appeal Tribunal, a board

member for Groves Memorial Hospital in Fergus and as president of the Rural Learning Association. She is also a professional playwright and published author.

At press time no Liberal candidate had been announced.
