



## A Lyons-sized donation!

The Georgetown Hospital Foundation recently received its second-largest-ever financial contribution by an individual as the Lyons family of the Caledon area donated more than \$260,000 to the hospital's Investing in Care Close to Home campaign. Lifelong dairy farmer John Lyons, who died in August 2010, years ago inherited the money from his cousin Pearl and invested it with the intention of leaving it to charity upon his passing. "John and I have been to Georgetown Hospital many times and always appreciated the care our family received here," said Jewel Lyons, John's wife of 61 years. The donation will be used to fund the construction of a new emergency room at the hospital, along with a CT scanner and the redevelopment of the Diagnostic Imaging Department. 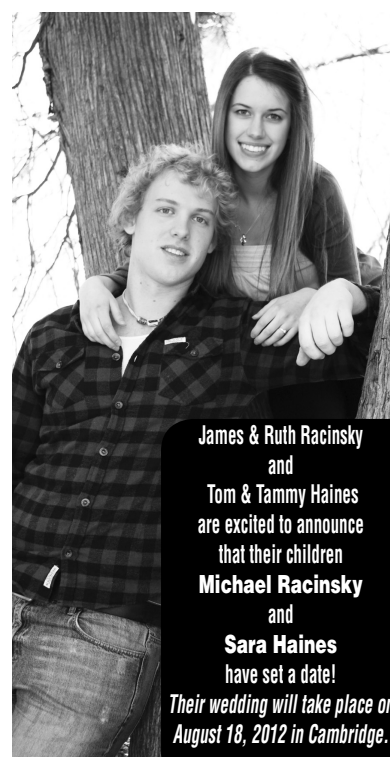
