Man shot in parking lot of Brampton plaza

A 24-year-old man was rushed to hospital after being shot in the parking lot of a Brampton plaza just days before Christmas.

Peel Regional Police say the victim was at a plaza located at 175 Fletchers Creek Blvd., near Bovaird Drive West, around 9 p.m. on Thursday, Dec. 21 when he was shot once while in the


parking lot outside the LA Fitness. The Brampton man suffered non-life threatening injuries and was taken to hospital where he remains.

There was a heavy police response with both canine and tactical officers heading to the scene. However, they were unable to locate the shooter, who had fled.

Police are searching for the attacker, but had limited information on his description to release other than he's a black man.

It's the second shooting in as many days in Brampton after police arrested and charged a 20-year-old man after multiple gunshots were fired near a plaza at McMurchy Avenue South and Queen Street West on Wednesday, Dec. 20.
