## Town receives \$50,000 for first asset management plan

The Town of Halton Hills has recently received confirmation that it has secured funding for its first management plan. The application to the Government of Canada and the Federation of Canadian Municipalities asked for funding toward the plan,

and it will come in the form of \$50,000. "The Federation of Canadian Municipalities launched the asset management grant in February, recognizing that the importance of strengthening the ability of cities and towns to better look after their infrastructure," Halton Hills Mayor Rick Bonnette said. "This investment allows the town to plan and study

our current and future inventory to ensure we continue to provide residents the best value for their tax dollars."The grant will be used to conduct a condition assessment of current assets, develop a strategy, work plan and policies to support the municipality in projecting future needs regarding budgets, maintenance and operations.
