GreenCarts will also be available free of charge while quantities last. You may continue to use your existing Blue Box.



Blue Box Pick-up Event conditions

- Halton residents only, proof of residency required
- Limit one Blue Box per household, while quantities last
- If picking up a Blue Box for a neighbour or family member, proof of residency is required for that additional address



Use Environment Canada’s Air Quality Health Index (AQHI) to make informed choices and to help plan outdoor activities. The AQHI measures outdoor air quality in relation to your health on a scale from 1 to 10+. The lower the number, the lower the risk. Protect your health. Know the numbers.
