A body found in Fairy Lake Tuesday morning has been identified as a 48-year-old Acton man.

Halton Police did not release the name of the man.

Police are still investigating, but say the incident isn't considered to be criminal in nature and there are no public safety

Stanley Hellam of Acton was walking his dog Duke Monday evening beside the lake in the Elizabeth Dr./Elmore Dr. area about 7:30 p.m. when he spotted what he thought was a dead goose floating about 20 metres from shore.
