The Halton Window and Door Company is an authorized drop-off centre for Bicycles for Humanity, a volunteer-run organization that collects gently-used bikes and sends them to communities in Africa. Business owners Anthony Maan (left) and Mike Patterson are collecting the bikes at the business's showroom, located at 374 Guelph St., Georgetown (corner of Guelph St. and Delrex Boulevard). Since it was founded in 2005, Bicycles for Humanity sent more than 20,000 bikes to people in Namibia, Malawi, South Africa and Uganda, and has created more than 90 bicycle repair jobs for people in Africa.
